In the beginning God made the heavens and the earth. God said, "Let there be a sky and let it divide the waters that are below from the waters that are above the sky."

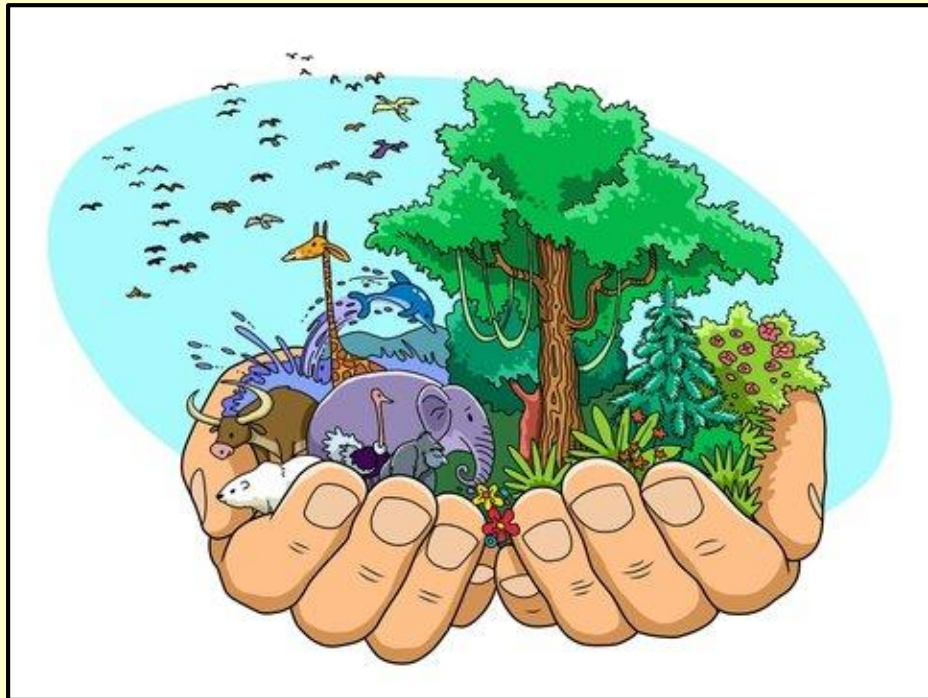
And God said, "Let plants and trees grow from the earth."
