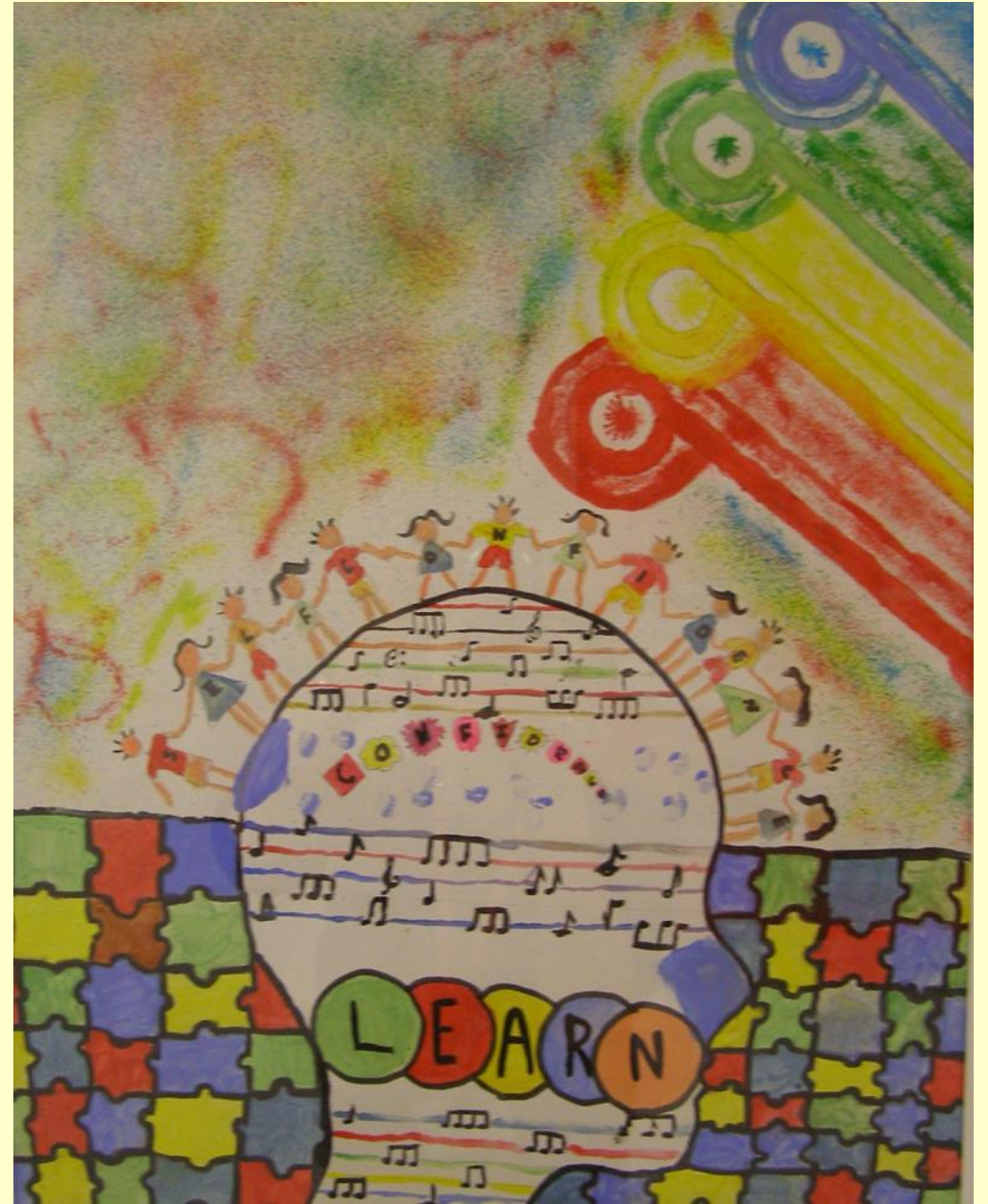

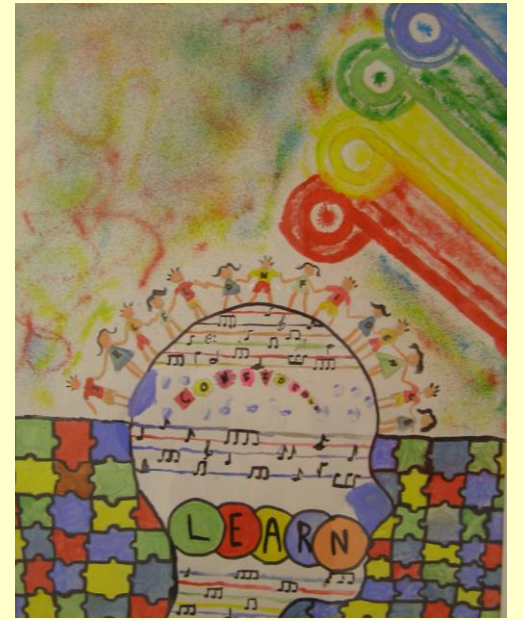
# Confident

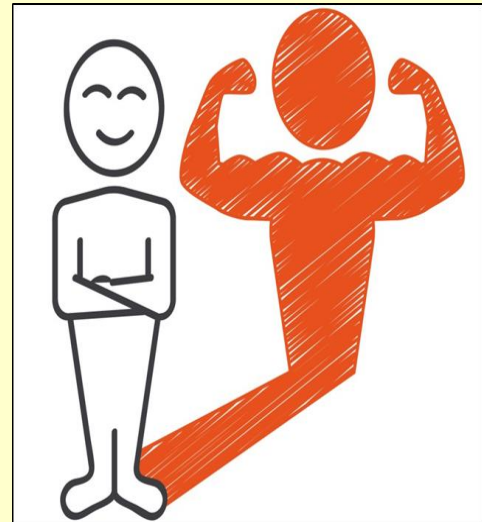
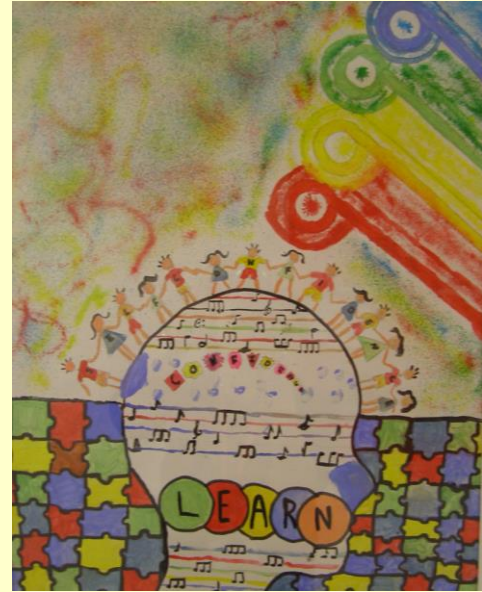
Dear Lord,
