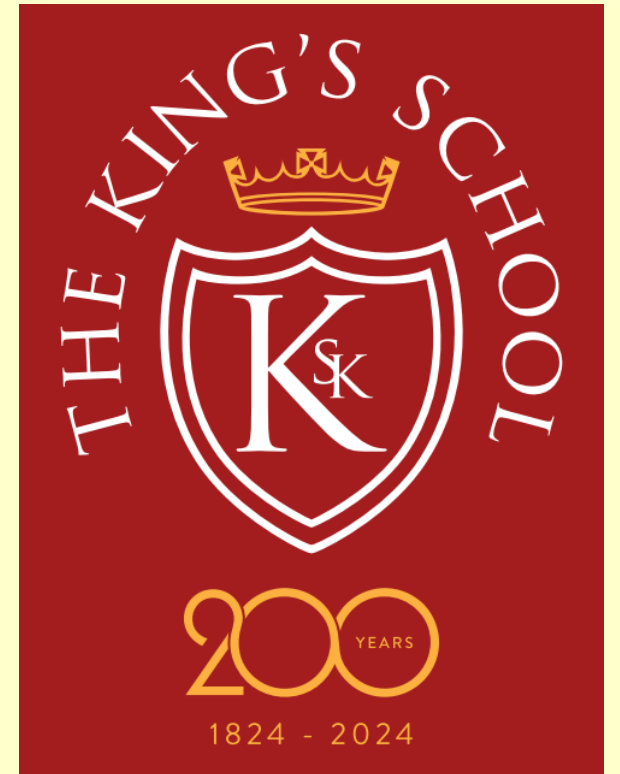

Dear God,

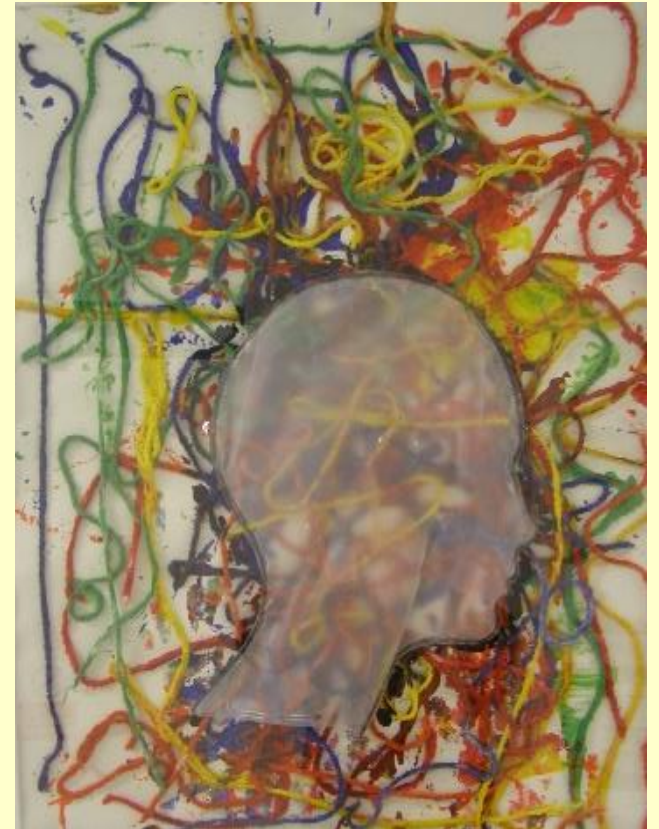
Please help us to have the strength to challenge and push ourselves
