Our experienced and dedicated staff team, who are committed to recognise and celebrate the uniqueness of every child, have built a culture of mutual respect between the different members of the school community. We have high expectations of staff and pupils, striving to achieve the highest standards, both pastorally and academically. We prepare children for the daily challenges they face in life and encourage them to be agents of change and responsible citizens of the future. We are proud to be part of the Southwark Diocesan Board of Education family of Church of England schools.

## Collective Worship

We maintain strong connections with the parishes of St. Anne's and St. Luke's with the Barn Church in Kew.

Our community at The King's School is diverse, and our Collective Worship aims to be inclusive and respectful of individual beliefs. We encourage all children to participate in Collective Worship and ensure all children feel valued as a member of The King's School family.

## Phased starts

To facilitate a smooth transition, we implement a staggered start for all EYFS children. This approach allows each child to begin their first day of school within smaller class sizes, ensuring individual attention. For this initial phase, children attend school only during the morning session. Over a period of three days, they gradually transition to staying for lunch and eventually moving to full-day attendance.



## Teaching and Learning

Each day, children have teacher input activity, including a daily phonics lesson. Following their adult led learning, children work with a teacher to complete scaffolded activities. To maximise learning opportunities, children have access to both an indoor and outdoor classroom, where independence and choice are encouraged.

All areas of the EYFS framework including reading, writing and mathematics are planned, each activity and all opportunities are appropriately adapted to meet each child's needs, deepening and extending their understanding. Within the carefully planned environment, stimulus and enhanced provision is used to excite, capture and motivate the children and provide learning opportunities.

## Wraparound care

At The King's CofE Primary School we offer wraparound provision.

Breakfast club opens at 7:45am.

Children enjoy a selection of activities and a range of breakfast options are provided.

After school club runs within the EYFS classroom from 3:20pm to 5pm.

## Early Years Foundation stage

The EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) Curriculum serves as the foundation for all learners at The King's School. This curriculum enables pupils to acquire a broad range of skills, knowledge, and understanding. We provide an extensive, experience-rich curriculum that is tailored to the needs and interests of each individual child, emphasizing whole-child development and fostering a love of learning. This approach ensures that children are engaged and motivated from the moment they start their educational journey at The King's School.

In Reception, our curriculum offers a variety of opportunities for children to acquire and develop new skills and knowledge, which are continually built upon as they progress through their learning journey at the school.

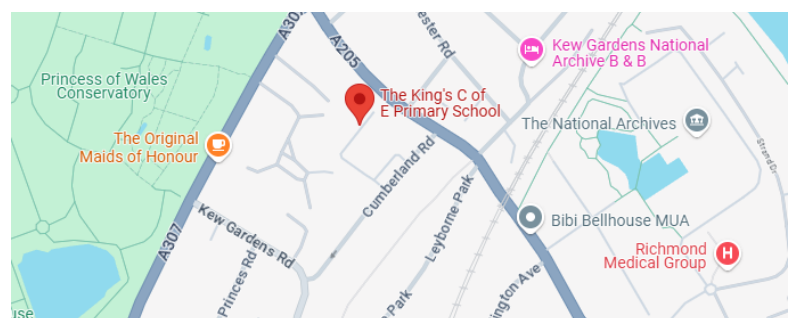
