<u>EYFS</u>	Children learn about jobs and roles in the community, focusing on people who help us. They explore their families, personal heroes, and create maps to understand their immediate environment.	Pupils discuss past experiences of celebrations and how different cultures mark special occasions such as Diwali, Bonfire Night, and Christmas. They also explore seasonal changes and their effects on the environment.	The focus shifts to Space , comparing Earth and other planets, learning about explorers like Mae Jemison, and mapping journeys.	Children learn about Easter and how it is celebrated around the world. They explore traditional tales from different cultures and study types of buildings from around the world.	This term focuses on Animals , habitats, and how human activity affects the environment. Pupils learn about figures like David Attenborough and Greta Thunberg and explore how dinosaurs show the world's changes over time.	Children explore Journeys - comparing environments, cultures, and transport across the world. They reflect on personal growth and changes over time, and engage with adventure stories and non-fiction about travel and exploration.
