Christmas art.

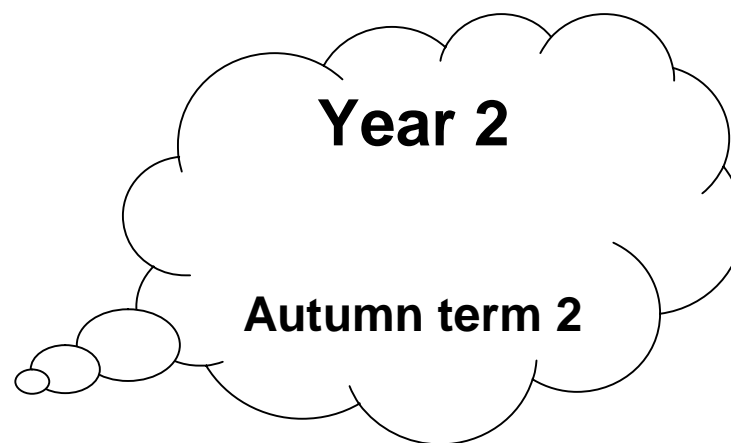
